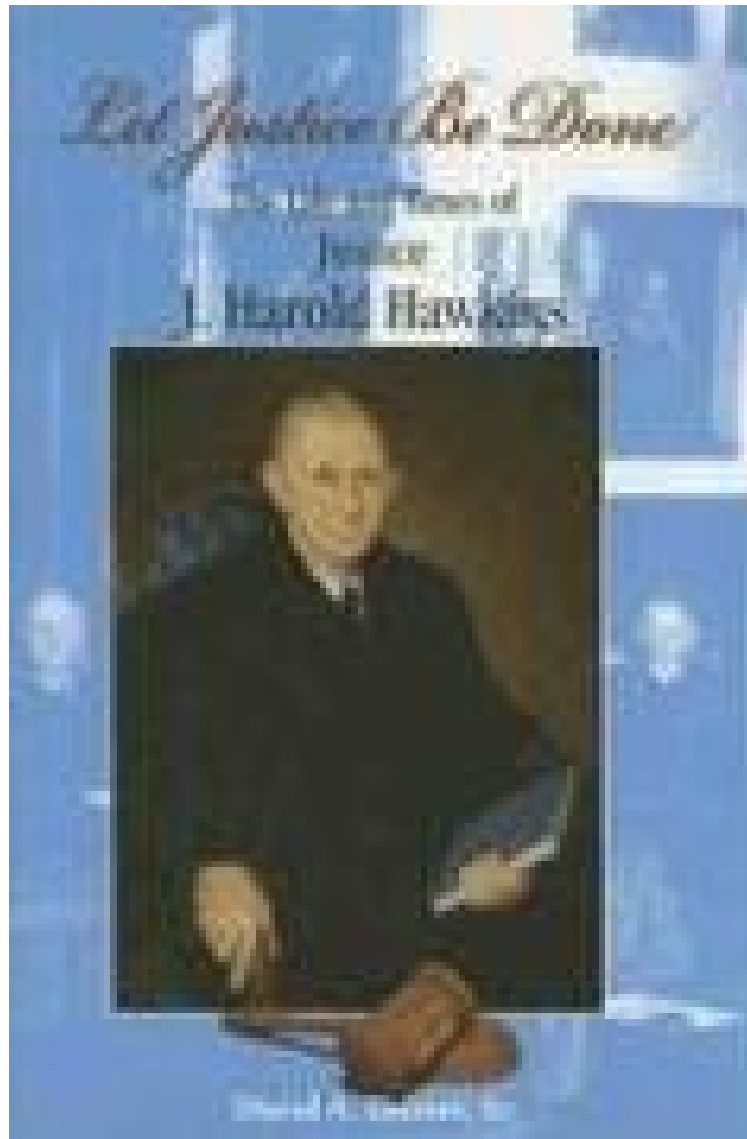

were committed by Bill Chappell, son of Carroll County Roads and Revenues Chairman Hamp Chappell. After Bill Chappell was convicted for the 2 murders, Hamp Chappell spent his ill-gotten fortune to pay for a pardon by then Governor Eugene Talmadge. Bill Chappell moved to Moultrie, Georgia, married and raised a family. Then in the early 1960's he was convicted for nearly beating a woman to death with a telephone .. sent to prison for 8 years. A few years later, Bill Chappell and his son Bill Chappell, Jr. were brought into court for committing a fraudulent conveyance (civil violation) in Carroll County together. The J. Ed Peek Murders, the trial and the pardon are covered in this book. Pictures from the era are abundant. Judge Harold Hawkins spoke about the amount of effort to bring murderers to justice .. only to have them pardoned by a corrupt governor.
