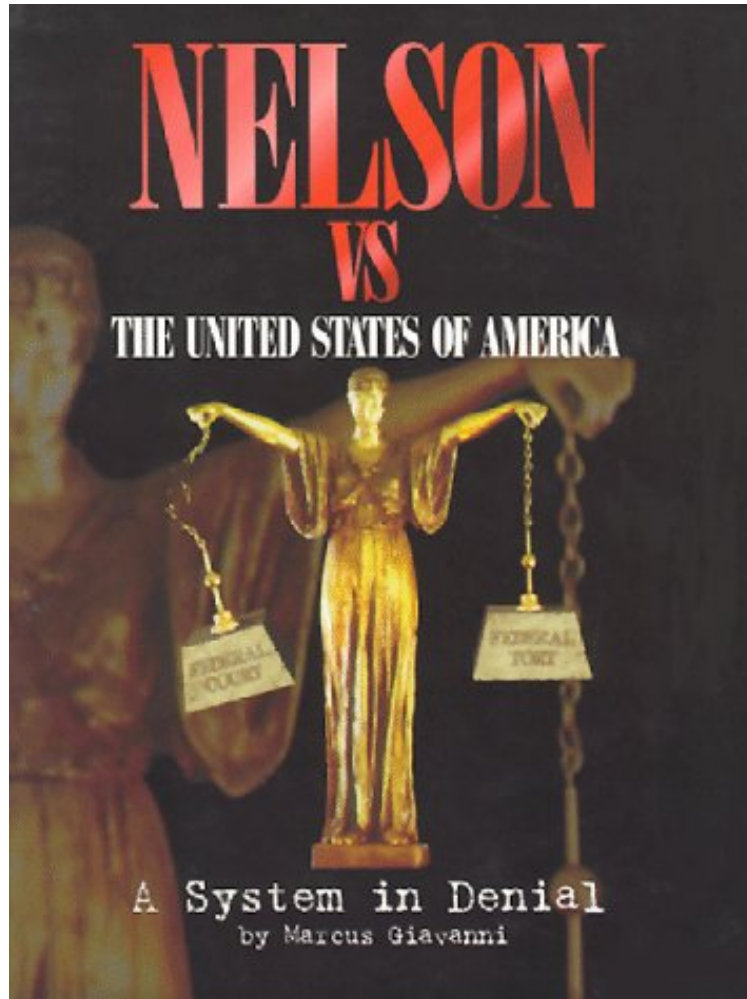

He tells what should have been a simple story of a wrongful arrest and takes the innocent reader through incoherent ramblings about his childhood and every slight (real or perceived) that he has encountered

throughout his entire life. It's clear that he is locked into a complete victim mentality coupled with a revenge compulsion: 'If you dare go against me (or I think you ever might), I will attack you with ridiculous charges and accusations.' I mention in another comment that Giavanni overuses exclamation points, omits entire words throughout his sentences, misspells common words and cannot handle a simple critique without lashing back with a personal attack. In reading the book, it is nearly impossible to follow Giavanni's logic even once you get past the disaster that is his "raw" writing style. He claims to have raised over \$350,000 to produce this book.
